16 huge transformers from Shanghai to Bandar Abbas, Iran (Turkmenistan Project)



As we mentioned in our former WS Newsletters: End of last year World Shipping China won a long-term project contract for shipments to Turkmenistan and started the first transports in Jan.2009. We are proud to announce that in May we started to move the biggest items for this project so far! For this lot we shipped 16 items as bulk cargo, incl. 4 pieces with 11300x4000x4000mm (LxWxH) and a weight of 23 tons each! Left and right you can see some of the cargo in the warehouse and during the loading at Shanghai port. In June the cargo arrived at Babdar Ababs, Iran from where it will be moved by truck to Turkmenistan (more about this shipment in the next WS Newsletter).



Generator from Long Beach, US to Xingang, China

In June 2009 our new office in Houston - "World Shipping Projects"- (please find more details below in the section "New developments") handled a project shipment of a PG Taurus 60 Generator Set from one of the leading Solar suppliers. The cargo loaded from the Port of Long Beach, California with destination Xingang, China. In order to ensure proper handling and timely delivery of this high profile shipment our team in Houston worked closely with the manufacturer, trucker and packers. The cargo could be loaded and shipped in record time and was received and transferred to the receiver by our colleagues in Xingang port.



Pressure test unit from US to Shanghai

Yet another project for our Houston office: In June our colleagues moved Pressure Test Units for one of our VIP clients from Houston to Shanghai. This high valued and out-of-gauge equipment was shipped on 6 flatracks as cargo (at the below picture you can see some items after loading and securing). Our staff in the US supervised all steps during the transport to ensure a smooth handling. In China, the cargo was received under the coordination of our Shanghai port operators who made sure the cargo was safely handed over to the receiver.

2 Power Transformers from China to Turkmenistan



For our Turkmenistan project we already shipped a lot of high value cargo for our client. And in May two further high-profile items were successfully moved by World Shipping: 2x 100KV Power Transformers (each with a weight of ca.38 tons) and equipment were shipped by container vessel from China to Bandar Abbas and from there by low-bed trucks to the jobsite in Turkmenistan. The left-hand picture shows you one transformer in Bandar Abbas port - after it was loaded and secured.



6 Backup Rolls from Hamburg, Germany to Qingdao, China

In May we could again provide our unique services to one of our VIP clients by importing 6 backup rolls from Hamburg port to Qingdao. The items had dimensions of 5.5x1.8x1.7m and a weight of each ca. 40tons. Despite the heavy weight per piece, we were able to ship the cargo with a conventional vessel to allow a convenient, economic and fast delivery! On the right-hand side you can see the items after they are loaded, secured and lashed on 40'Flat Racks in Hamburg port.



Blast Furnace equipment to Vietnam

As yet another part of our on-going contract for the delivery of equipment for a blast furnace in Vietnam saw in May the delivery of 15TEU's and more than 3400cbm of equipment as break bulk cargo to Haiphong, Vietnam. It was already the 5th shipment under this contract! The cargo was loaded under our supervision in Tianjin as well as in Qingdao, China and was being shipped in one vessel to Vietnam! Perfect coordination was one more time the key-point for this successful shipment!
