**Import of heavy-lift cargo from Germany**



In July 2009 we handled an import of construction machinery from Germany with ca. 50TEU (incl. several special container). All cargo was moved with by a container vessel, incl. one item of break bulk cargo with dimensions of 11.5x3.4x3.5m (LxWxH) and a weight of 148 tons (!). Our very good connections to the carrier helped us to get the allowance to load such extra-ordinary cargo on a container vessel. Please see the cargo during the discharging with a floating crane (left hand side) and after loading on a multi-axis truck (right-hand side). All activities were supervised by our port operators to ensure the correct and speedy handling.



**Equipment for Cement Plant from Hamburg to Durres, Albania**

Yet another lot for a project shipment Albania was shipped in July. This time World Shipping decided to ship the oversized items with total dimensions of 222cbm and 130 tons on Flat Rack's from Hamburg to Durres port (via Italy). Although Durres port has no facilities to handle Flat Rack's, World Shipping could arrange the safe discharging at this port where these containers were loaded directly on the waiting trucks and delivered to the receiver. This shipment-mode make sure that the transfer was handled in the most economic and smooth way for the benefits of our client! The right-hand picture shows some of the items after they were secured on one of the Flat Rack's.



**Blast Furnace import**

World Shipping China has an excellent reputation for handling difficult requirements. One of our clients wanted to ship ca. 15TEU from two suppliers (one located in Sweden, the other in Switzerland) in one lot to China. We arranged the transfer from both origins by feeder and trucks simultaneously, so that both lots arrived Rotterdam port at the same time. In that way we could make sure that the waiting time as well as the storage costs were minimal. After discharging at Qingdao, China we also delivered the cargo to our satisfied client.

**Import of Equipment from Gothenburg**

In July World Shipping had another impressive import shipment from Europe. One 1x40'DV and one Break Bulk item (43.5 tons) was moved from Gothenburg, Sweden via Hamburg to Dalian. The single unit had dimensions of 14.65m x 3.08m x 3.62m needed a special packaging to ensure a safe handling in the ports. On the picture below you can see the details)



**Equipment on Flat Racks ex Houston to Shanghai**



A new successful cooperation shipment between World Shipping and its new brand in Houston could be seen in July as we moved 17 out-of-gauge boxes from Houston to Shanghai. All of the items had overheights and -width and were shipped on Flat Rack containers on a container vessel. While our colleagues in the US office arranged the packing and pick-up from the producer, our local staff made sure the cargo was quickly delivered to the receiver after it was discharged at Shanghai port. - As you can see, World Shipping successfully established a new bridge between the US and the Chinese market.
